Curriculum Change Policies and Procedures  
Department of Psychology  
(approved: 2/08)

Proposals to change the undergraduate or graduate curriculum may be initiated by any member of the faculty. Formal proposals, prepared on the required College forms and in consultation with the Department's College Curriculum Committee representative, should be submitted to the Chair of the department. The Chair will forward proposals to the appropriate departmental curriculum committee for consideration. The committee will review proposals on their merit (and may suggest modifications to the proposal) and will bring them to the entire faculty for a vote. Only those proposals supported by a majority of the faculty will go forward. The Chair of the Department will submit approved proposals to College Curriculum Committee via the Department's College Curriculum Committee representative.
